

## **Computing**

Children are given opportunities to use digital technology including computers, tablets, cameras, recording equipment, remote control and monitoring equipment to experience a broad and balanced computing curriculum as well as to enhance cross curricular links. They learn to search for, collect, evaluate, manipulate, control, create and exchange digital information using a variety of hardware and software and develop computational thinking and problem solving skills. Keeping safe online is an integral part of the curriculum.

Children have access to a computer suite with 17 computers as well as laptops in every classroom and 30 tablets. All classrooms are fully equipped with interactive whiteboards.
