My Mum 2018

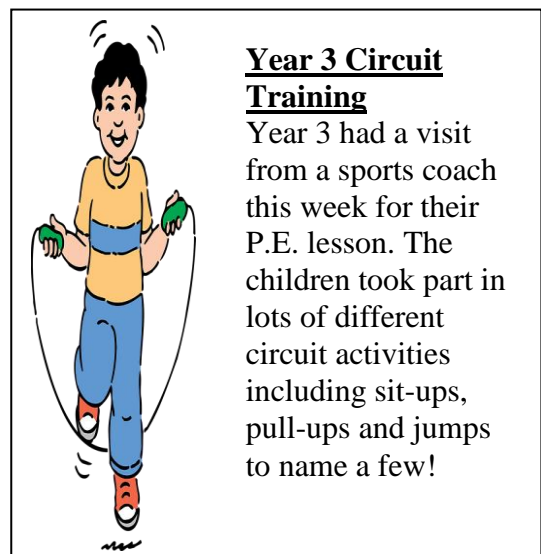
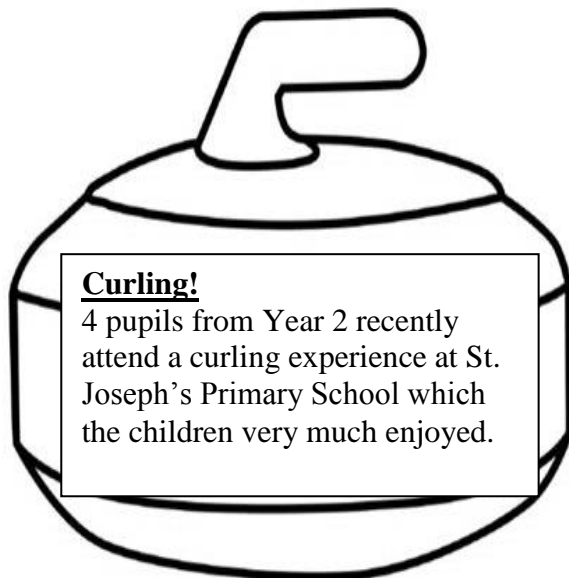
