New Year Resolutions

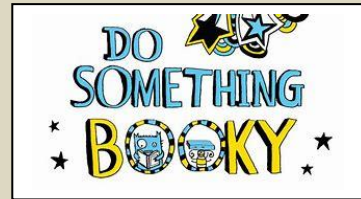
Please let the school office know if your child kept their New Year Resolution during the month of January so that I can present them with a certificate for their efforts.
